



Helpful Tips:

1. Everything should be built using no tools.
2. Don't overtighten the wingnuts. The material will dent and pucker.
3. You will have extra parts, those are spares.
4. Make sure to work from left to right to ensure that your connectors line up correctly with the stands.
5. Always weight your ground stands well.
6. Do not use these ground support stands outside or in areas of un-controlled wind.

Step 1:

Attach the foot to the upright of your stand. Match the green sticker to the other green stickers as shown. Make sure the bolt and wingnut are away from the channel.

Step 2:

Attach the cross brace matching the blue and red stickers together as shown below.



Step 3:

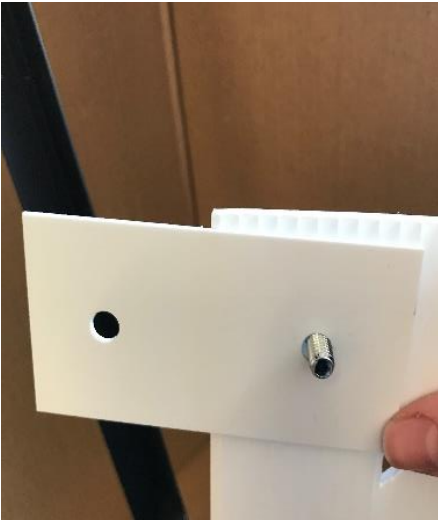
Lay out your stands approximately 24" apart with sand bags on the back of each.

Step 4:

Insert a 3/4" bolt through the bottom left corner of your first panel, then through a 2-way connector.



Next slide the bolt through the bottom corner of the ground support stand and secure with a wingnut.

Step 5:

Insert a bolt through the top left corner of the panel, through another 2-way connector and then through the stand. (Leaving the second hole on the connector pointing upwards)



Step 6:

Insert a 3/4" bolt through the right bottom corner of the panel, through a 2-way connector and then through the second stand.

Step 7:

Insert a 3/4" bolt through the top right corner of the panel, a 4-way connector and then the stand. The empty holes in the connector should be above and to the right of the bolt.

**Step 8:**

Using steps 4-7, add a panel above the one you just added.

Step 9:

Then add a panel on the right, bottom side.



Step 10:

Repeat steps 4-9 until desired height and width are reached.



Step 11:

Enjoy your finished product.
